Some of the best food on the ship can be found in the **Main Dining Room**. Meals here are multi-course affairs paired with white tablecloth service and spotlight dishes from around the world. Each night you'll find a different menu and you'll find the chefs always deliver!



One of the specialty restaurants onboard, **Giovanni's Table** feels like true Italian trattoria complete with a menu filled with hearty family-style favorites. While the restaurant is favored for its pasta, the non-pasta options are equally impressive, including the veal and lamb chops.



If you're looking for a more casual dining option onboard, we recommend the **Windjammer Cafe**. Meals here are included in your sailing and you will find quality food from around the world for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
